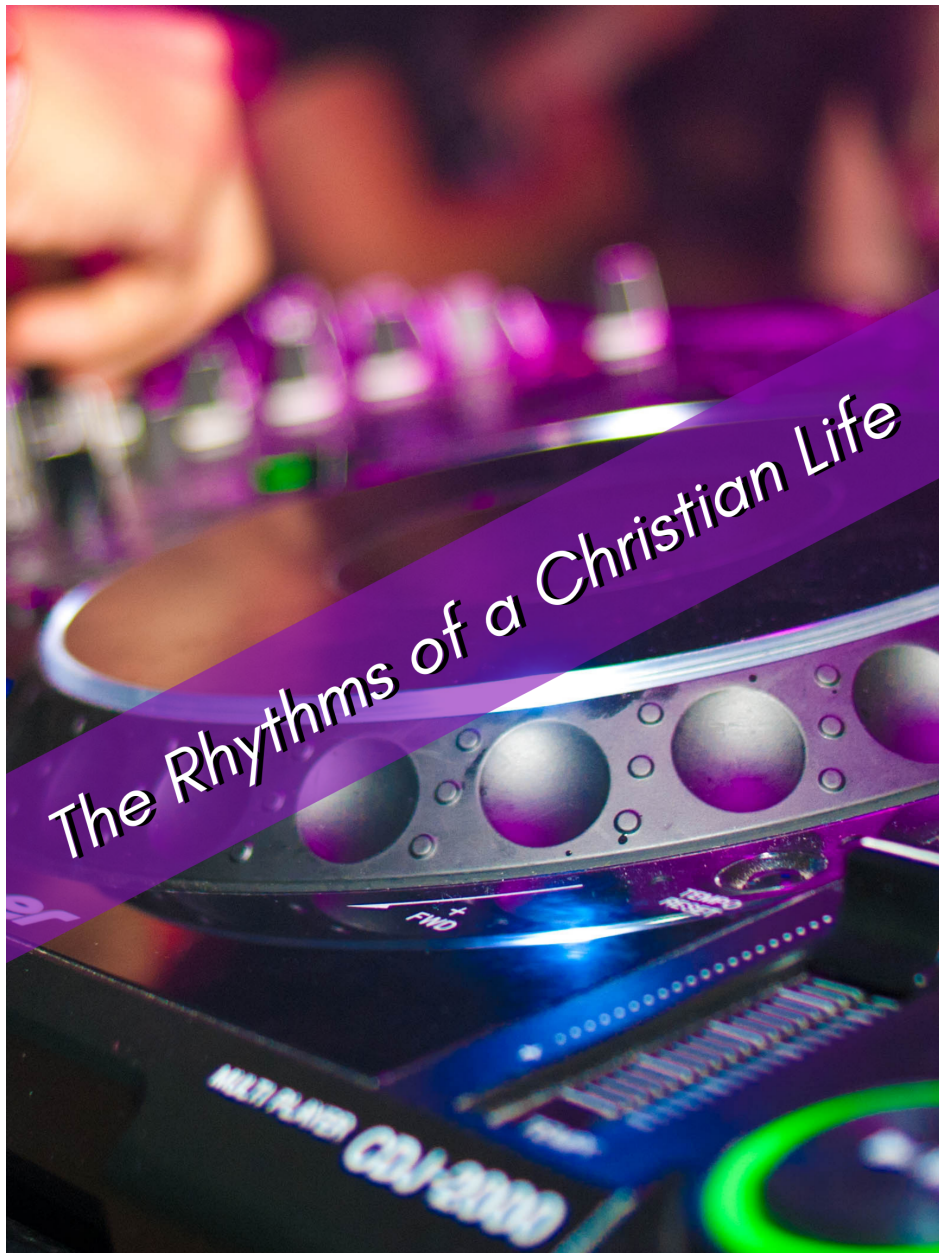

### **How do we avoid being inconsistent in our faith?**

#### **1. Make time for prayer.**
