New Testament - Matthew 5:13-20-NRSV

¹³ *"You are the salt of the earth; but if salt has lost its taste, how can its saltiness be restored? It is no longer good for anything, but is thrown out and trampled underfoot.*

¹⁴ *"You are the light of the world. A city built on a hill cannot be hid. ¹⁵ No one after lighting a lamp puts it under the bushel basket, but on the lampstand, and it gives light to all in the house.*

¹⁶ *In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in heaven.*
